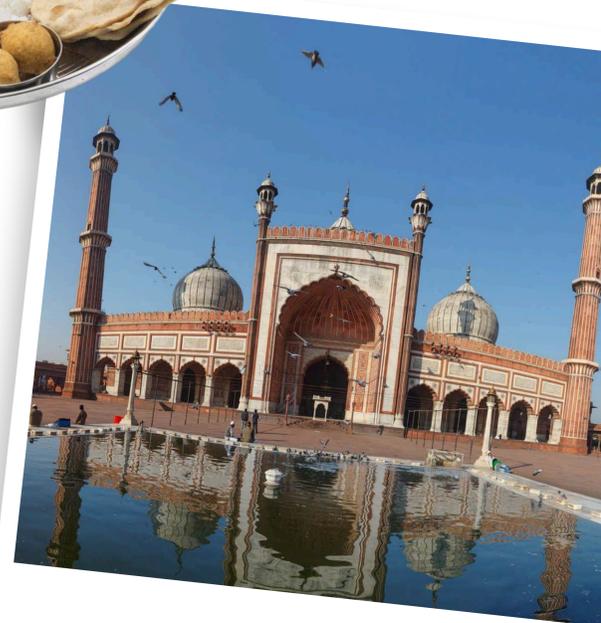

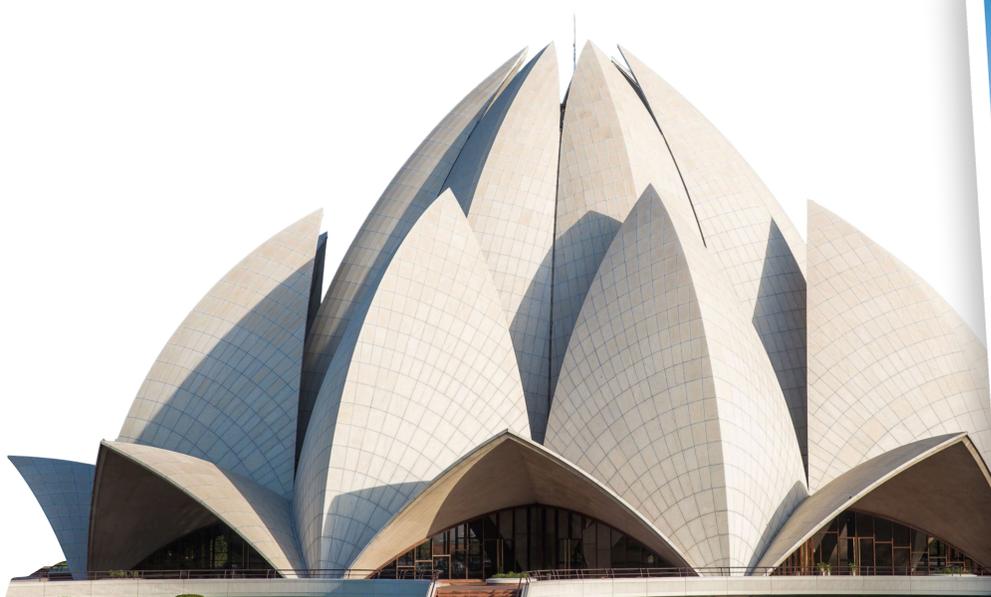
Nimalar qilish mumkin?
