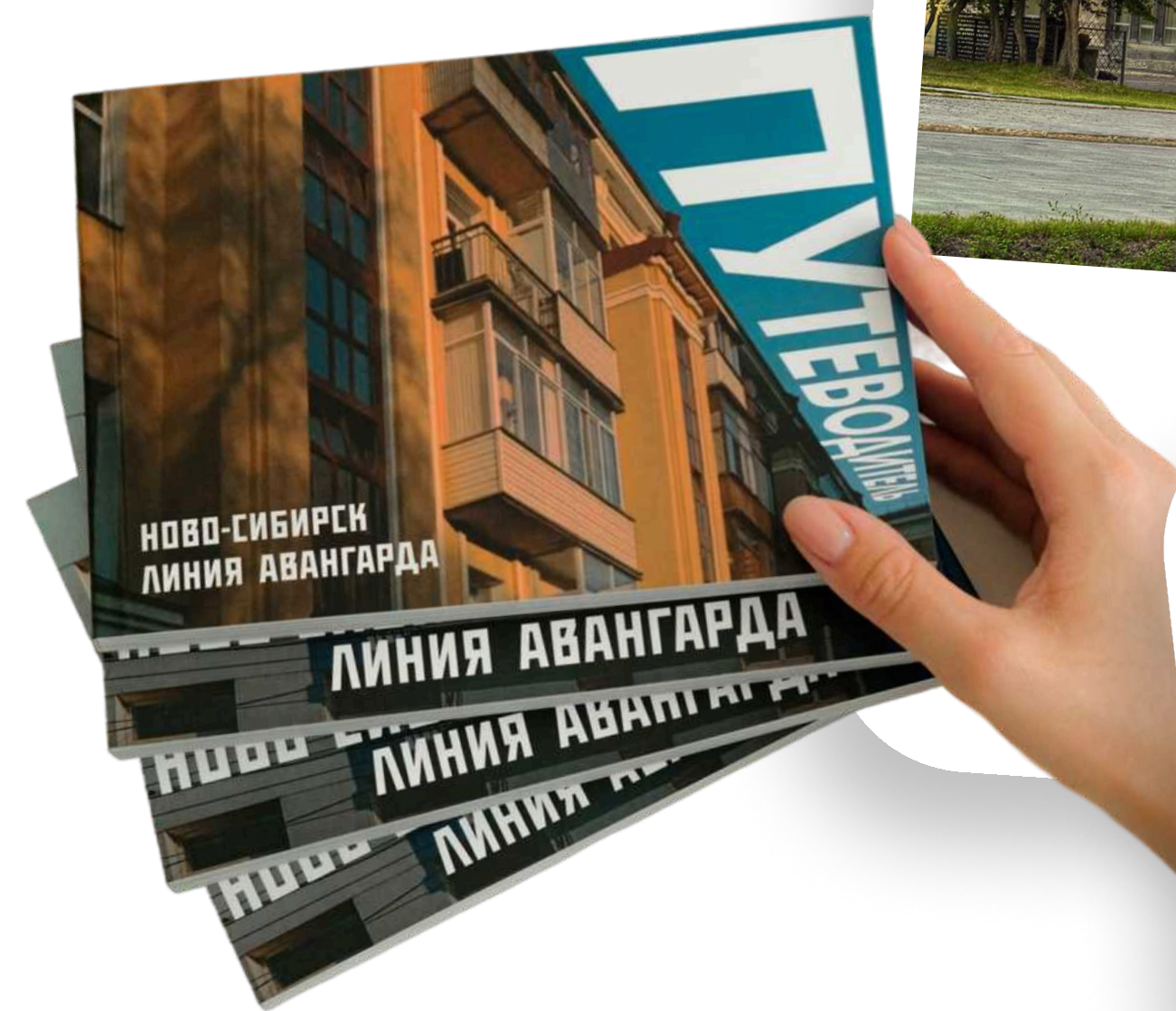


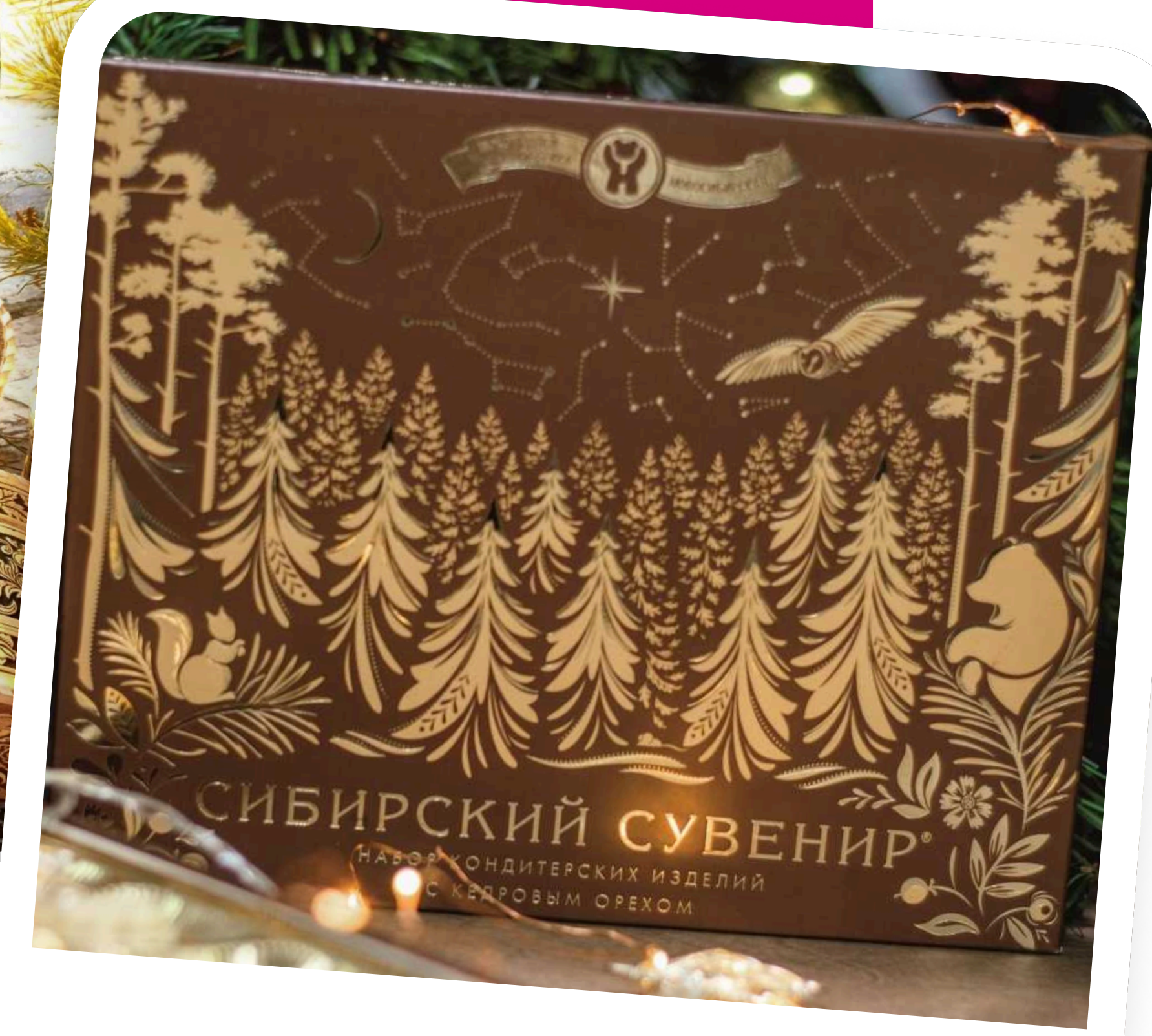
# Welcome to Novosibirsk

- Local "Pyshki" (traditional Siberian donuts)
- Game delicacies (venison and wild meat)
- Stroganina (traditional frozen thin-sliced meat or fish)
- Local fish: Peled and Pike
