
Places to visit

TOP things to do in Namangan

- Visit the International Flower Festival in May and June, when millions of flowers adorn the city
- Spend a day at the Afsonalar vodiysi amusement park («Valley of Legends») with the largest Ferris wheel in Central Asia, roller coasters and water slides, an aquapark with pools
- Visit the craftsmen's workshops: the city is famous for its weavers, potters, blacksmiths, and jewelers
- See the treasures at the Namangan Regional History Museum
- Visit the Art Gallery, which is located in the former Ot Valikhon Tur Mosque building
- Walk around the Babur Park of Culture and Recreation and sit in the teahouse
- Go to the performance of the Namangan Regional Theatre of Musical Drama and Comedy named after Alisher Navoi
- Enjoy shopping at the Chorsu Bazaar
- Admire the architecture and interiors of the Mulla-Kyrgyz Madrasah and the Khodja Amin Kabri Mausoleum
- Try dozens of types of samosa at the «Samsa markazi» Center and see the largest tandyr for making somsa in Uzbekistan


TOP things to do outside Namangan

- Take a tour of the «Bibionamazor» archaeological site (near Chust) with the Bibi Ona-Kaynar bulok spring, which is considered the beginning of all holy springs
- Visit the Sultan Uvais Karani pilgrimage complex, the largest sanctuary in the Namangan region, which houses the second-largest handwritten Qur'an in Uzbekistan
- Visit the tomb of Bibi Naima Ona and the pond at its foot with crystal-clear water
- Visit the skullcap-making workshop in Chust, which is considered the birthplace of this headdress
- See the «Crying Rock» in the ancient village of Chodak
- Improve your health at the «Chortoq» balneological resort
- Reach the ruins of the ancient city of Akhsikent, which was the capital of the Fergana Valley
