



Welcome to Bukhara

Places to visit

- See the two main symbols of the city — the Ark Citadel and the architectural complex of Poi Kalyan
- Climb the Shukhov Tower
- Explore one of the oldest madrasahs — Ulugh Beg Madrasah, the beautiful Abdulaziz Khan Madrasah, and the unique Chor-Minor Madrasah
- Admire the luxurious decor of the summer residence of the last Emir of Bukhara — the Sitorai Mokhi-Khosa Palace
- Stroll under the famous trading domes of Bukhara — from Lyabi-Hauz to Miri-Arab Madrasah
- Be amazed by the beauty of the ayvan decorated with majolica at the Khanaka of Divan-Begi
- Relax by the pond at one of the cafes on Lyabi-Hauz
- Discover paintings of Bukhara at the Museum of Fine Arts, located in the former store of Savva Morozov
- Stay at one of the boutique hotels
- Soak in the atmosphere of the old town's narrow streets
- See how wealthy Bukharans lived at the House-Museum of Merchant Fayzulla Khodjaev
- Enjoy a steam bath in the ancient Bukhara hammams with massage and herbal tea
- Take a photo with the statue of Khoja Nasreddin on Lyabi-Hauz Square
- Attend a folklore show with dancing and a traditional clothing display at the Nadir Divan-Begi Madrasah
- Learn the secrets of making traditional papier-mâché dolls at Iskandar Hakimov's workshop
- Visit a local artisan to learn about knife-making, Bukhara carpet weaving, traditional clothing, winemaking, or miniature painting and calligraphy
- Visit the local bazaar
- Take a guided tour and wine tasting at the «Shokhrud» winery
- Travel to the ceramic center of Gijduvan (40 km from Bukhara) and try Gijduvan shashlik
- Relax by Tudakul Lake and taste the local fish
