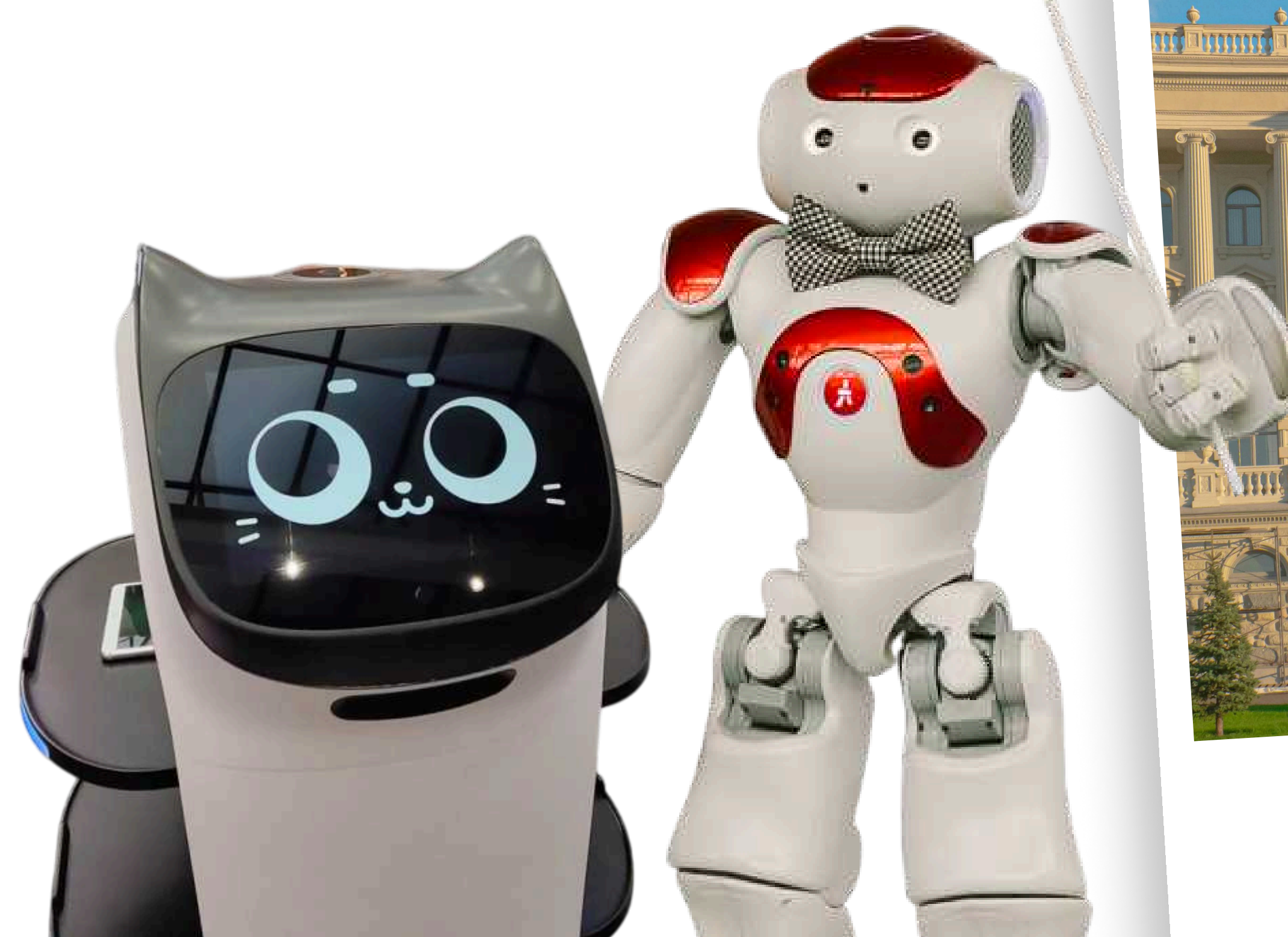
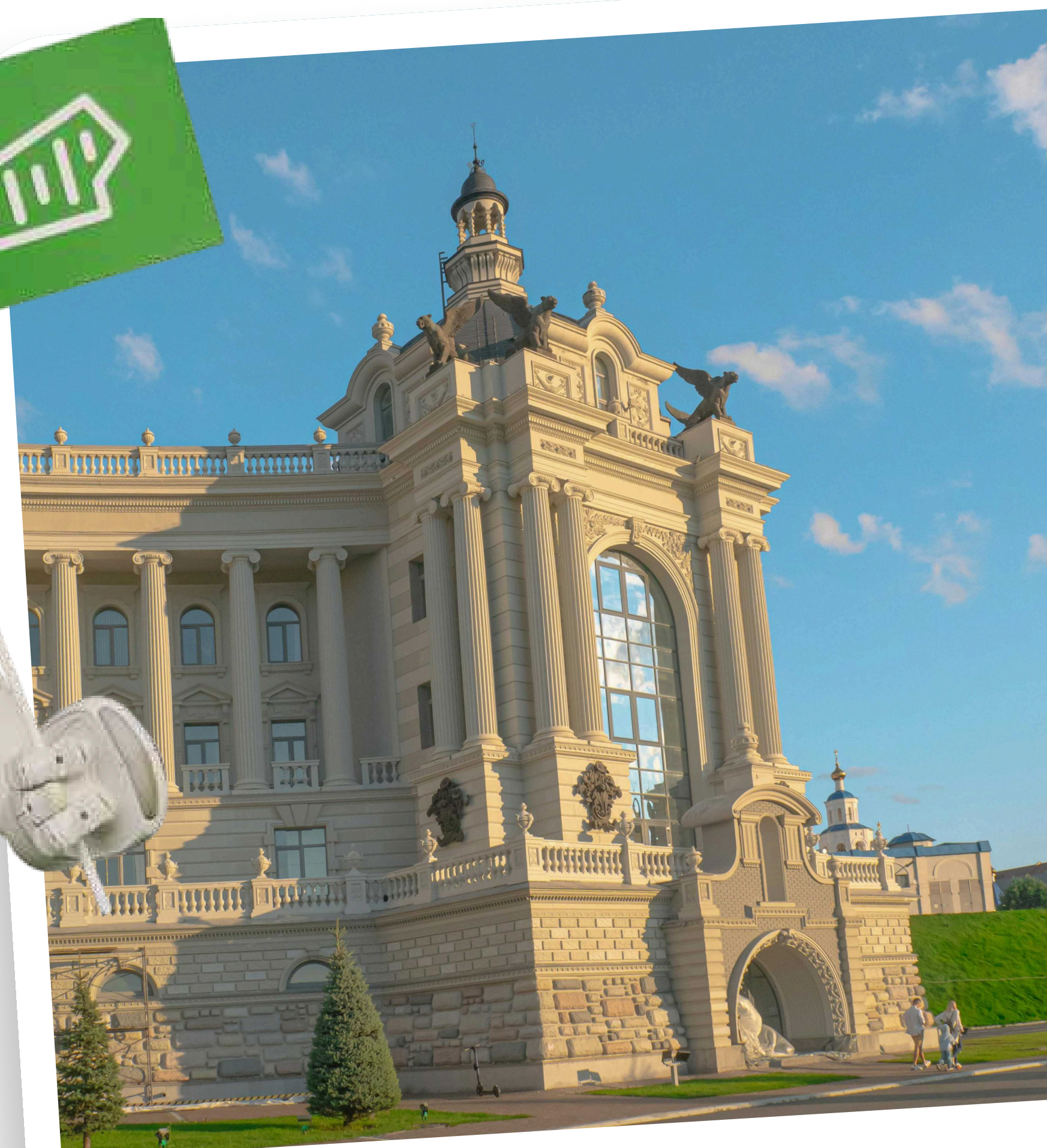


Welcome to Kazan

Did you know that...



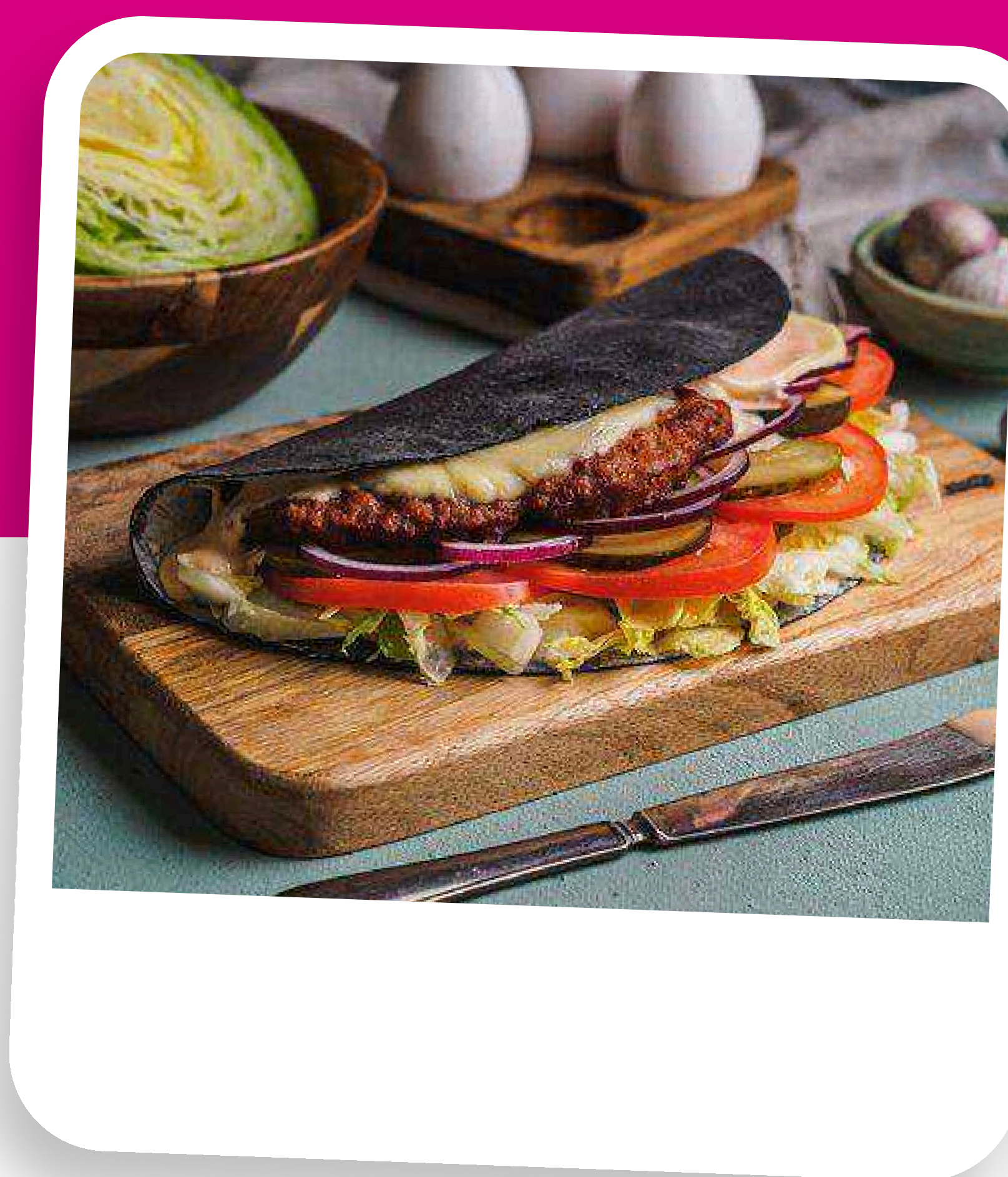
...the Kazan Oceanarium has the longest aquarium in Europe – 52 meters?
