Places to visit


- Bargain at Chorsu Bazaar.
- Visit the metro stations Alisher Navoi, Mustaqillik Maydoni, Kosmonavtlar, and Paxtakor — each with its own unique design.
- See the world's oldest Quran at the Hazrati Imam Complex
- Admire the snow-white Minor Mosque
- Visit Independence Square
- Go up the Tashkent TV Tower to a height of 110 meters
- Enjoy the evening fountain shows in Magic City Park, Tashkent City, or the Seoul Mun Mall
- Explore artisan shops in the Navruz Ethnopark
- Stroll along the Anhor embankment and watch the water cascades
- Discover Tashkent's modernist architecture
- Join a walking tour — “Speaking Tashkent” or one by the X-places Tashkent community
- Visit the Center of Islamic Civilization — museum, library, and crafts center
- Take part in a workshop at Human House
- Explore the Museum of Applied Arts
- Visit one of the city's main museums — the Central Exhibition Hall of the Academy of Arts of Uzbekistan or the State Museum of History of Uzbekistan (currently under renovation)
- Try authentic plov at the Besh Qozon Plov Center or the Plov Museum, and watch how it's cooked in giant cauldrons
- Attend a performance at the Alisher Navoi Theater
- Walk around the modern Tashkent City district with its skyscrapers and restaurants
- Relax in one of Tashkent's parks — Japanese Garden, Blue Domes Boulevard, or Mustaqillik Square Park
- Hunt for vintage treasures or quirky finds at the Yangiabad Flea Market

- Admire the turquoise waters of the Charvak Reservoir, surrounded by the picturesque Chimgan Mountains

- See the unique solar furnace and enjoy the view from the Institute of the Sun observation deck


