What to do?

Top things to do in Khabarovsk

- Take a stroll along the city's main historical street – Muravyov-Amursky Street
- 2Cross the Amur (Khabarovsk) Bridge – the one featured on the 5000-ruble banknote
- Go on a river cruise along the Amur River
- Spend the evening at the Admiral Nevelskoy Embankment
- Walk through Muravyov-Amursky Park – the most beautiful and well-maintained in the city
- Climb the Amur Cliff (also called Starukhina Gora), a symbol of the region
- Feed ducks, geese, and red-eared turtles in the cozy Severny Park
- Marvel at the grandeur of the Transfiguration Cathedral – one of the tallest in Russia
- Try Far Eastern and Chinese cuisine, along with local delicacies
- Discover the history and culture of the Khabarovsk region at the N.I. Grodekov Regional Museum
- Attend a performance at the Khabarovsk Regional Musical Theater

Top things to do outside of Khabarovsk

- See over 110 species of animals and birds at the V.P. Sysoev "Priamursky" Zoological Garden
- Admire the stunning views of the Bolshekhekhtsirsky Nature Reserve, the Amur River, and Khabarovsk itself from the Two Brothers Hill
- Hike to the summit of Snake Hill – the most picturesque spot in the Khekhtsirsky Wildlife Refuge
- Witness a natural wonder – blooming lotus lakes in July and August
- Explore the unusual "Stone Waterfalls" in Novokamenka
- Find ancient petroglyphs in the village of Sikachi-Alyan
- Learn more about rare Amur tigers at the Durninskoye hunting reserve in the heart of the Ussuri taiga
- Be amazed by the majesty of the Amur Pillars – giant stone monoliths
- Go fishing on the Amur River and catch Amur pike or local catfish



What to bring back?

- Schisandra (magnolia vin) jam
- Meat delicacies
- Pine nuts
- Dried fish
- Red caviar



What to try?

- “Taksa” fish pâté with sauces made from local berries – lingonberry, blueberry, or cloudberry
- Byansi – fish dumplings
- Talu – stroganina made from freshly frozen red fish fillet
- Far Eastern salad with red fish
- Dishes with bracken fern
