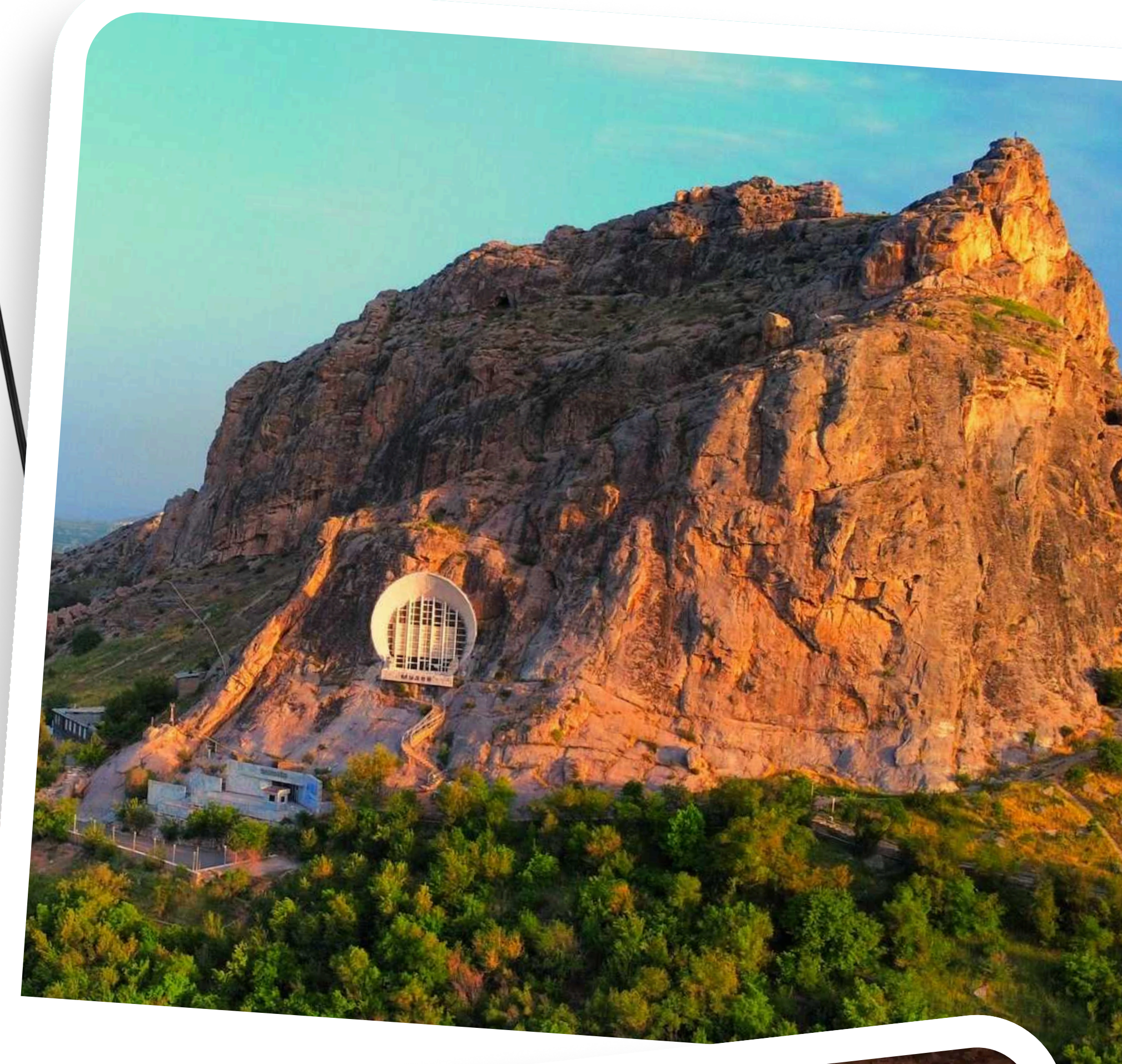

What to do?



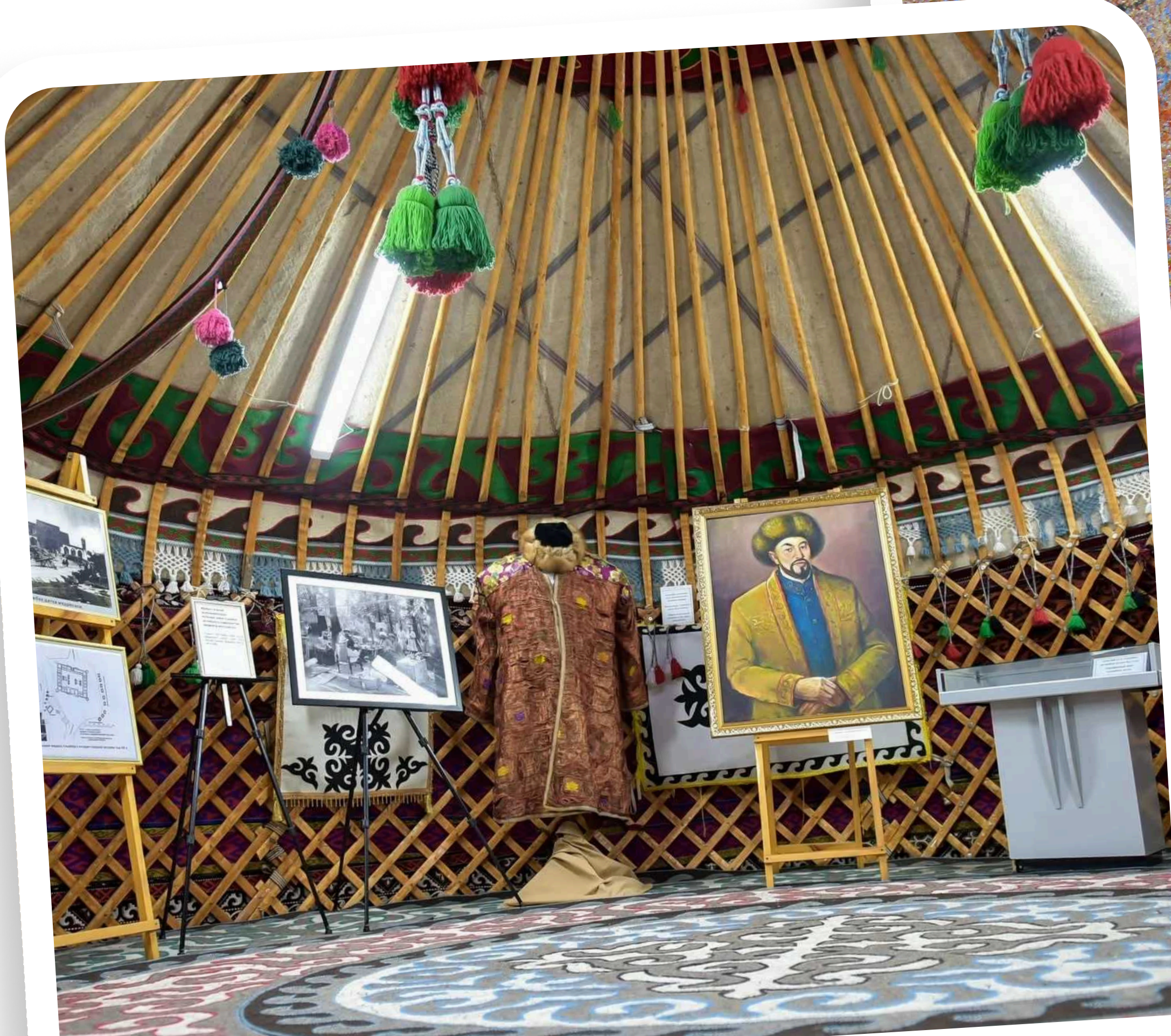
Top things to do in the city

- Climb the five-peaked Sulaiman-Too Mountain – the country's first UNESCO World Heritage site
- Visit the Sulaiman-Too National Historical and Archaeological Museum, located right inside a mountain cave
- Haggle at Jayma Bazaar and stock up on treasures like carpets, jewelry, and traditional Kyrgyz clothing
- Stroll through the shaded alleys of Navoi, Ak-Buura, or Alymbek Datka parks
- Photograph the unique three-story yurt – the Alymbek Datka Museum located in the eponymous park
- Traveling with kids? Stop by the small zoo in Navoi Park



Top things to do outside the city

- Gear up, hire a guide, and set off to conquer the surrounding mountain peaks
- Travel to "Walnut Paradise" – the village of Arslanbob, home to the largest walnut forest in the world. You'll also find waterfalls and observation decks with stunning mountain views nearby
- Explore Uzgen, an ancient city on the banks of the Kara-Darya River in the Fergana Valley
- Photograph the "Heavenly Horses" of Aravan – ancient rock carvings of horses
- Admire stalactites and stalagmites (some up to 350 million years old) in the Chil-Ustun caves
- Enjoy the mountain air, horseback riding, and nature in Kara-Shoro National Park or Kyrgyz-Ata Park
- Witness a unique waterfall gushing directly out of a cliff in the Abshir-Sai valley
