What to do?

- Admire the scale and beauty of the region's main shrine – the Heart of Chechnya mosque
- Enjoy the city panorama from the observation deck at Grozny City
- Go shopping at one of the largest malls in the Caucasus – Grozny Mall
- Relax at the Chernorechenskoye Reservoir and enjoy the light-and-music fountain
- Stroll through the Flower Park, home to over 150,000 blooming plants
- Walk along Mahmud Esambaev Boulevard – the city's main restaurant and only pedestrian street
- Attend a performance at the Kh. Nuradilov Chechen State Drama Theatre or the Grozny Russian Drama Theatre
- Visit the Grozny Dolphinarium – the largest in the North Caucasus
- Cheer for the local team or take a tour of Akhmat Arena Stadium
- Watch the races at the "Krepost Groznaya" Autodrome, the largest in the North Caucasus
- Take a walk through one of the city's green areas, such as the Hussein bin Talal Park
- Explore Grozny at night and marvel at its artistic illumination
- Learn more about the region's history at the National Museum of the Chechen Republic
- Discover the applied arts collection at the Akhmat Kadyrov State Gallery
- Enjoy a breathtaking night view of the city from the Stairway to Heaven observation deck
- Take spectacular photos with the English Castle as your backdrop

## Top things to do outside Grozny

- Relax at the all-season mountain resort Veduchi
- Take countless photos of Kezenoy-Am, the largest high-mountain lake in the North Caucasus
- Drive through the Argun Gorge and see the Nikhaloy Waterfalls
- Discover that one of the world's largest mosques – the Pride of Muslims in Shali – was designed by specialists from Uzbekistan

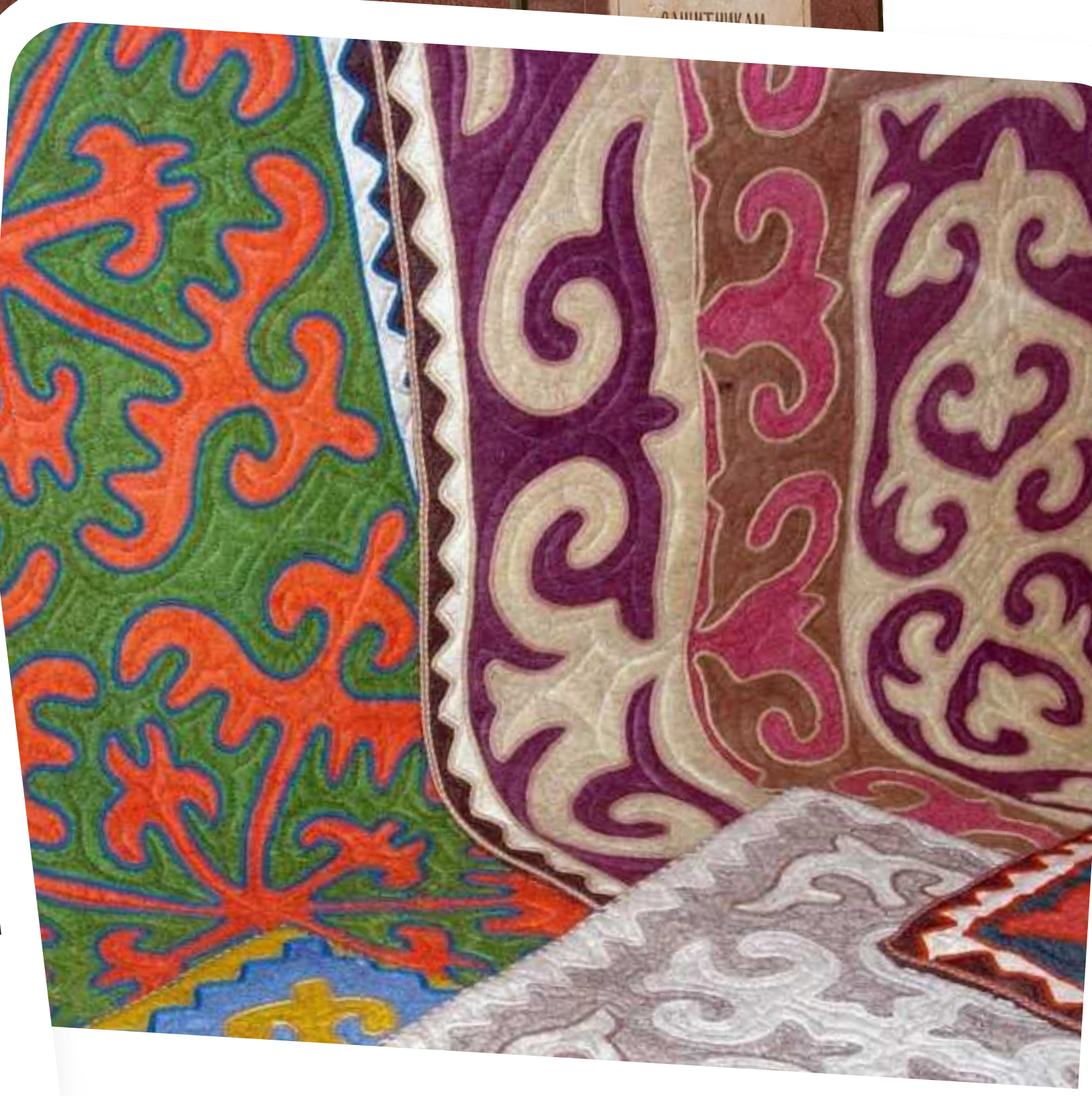

## What to bring back?

- Chechen halva (deman-khovlu)
- Pickled wild garlic – known locally as “Chechen asparagus”
- Brass or metal jewelry
- A traditional sheepskin papakha hat
- Woven istangi rugs with national ornaments



## What to try?

- Shashlik (grilled meat)
- Khingalsh – flatbread stuffed with pumpkin
- Kholtamash – a dish resembling dumplings or manty
- Zhizhig-galnash – meat served with dough dumplings
