Welcome to Baku

- Admire the spectacular light show on the three Flame Towers skyscrapers
- Visit the Heydar Aliyev Center – a masterpiece of modern architecture and an iconic symbol of Baku
- Get lost in the charming narrow streets of the Old City (Icheri-Sheher)
- Walk along the Baku Boulevard and Seaside Park by the Caspian Sea
- Ride the funicular to Highland Park for the most breathtaking panoramic views of the city
- Glide through "Little Venice" on an authentic Italian gondola along its 1.5 km canal system
- Get a bird's-eye view of the city from the Baku Eye Ferris wheel
- Enjoy a peaceful sailing cruise across the beautiful Baku Bay
- Indulge in a shopping spree on the vibrant Nizami Street
- Visit Villa Petrolea, the historic former residence of the Nobel brothers
- Wander through the Palace of the Shirvanshahs, a crown jewel of Azerbaijani architecture
- Explore the stunning Taza Pir Mosque, one of the most beautiful in the country
- Shop for fresh local flavors and seasonal fruits at the Yashil Bazaar (Green Market)
- Admire the lavish interiors of the National Museum of History of Azerbaijan
- Marvel at the vast collection of over 14,000 rugs at the Azerbaijan Carpet Museum
- Relax and recharge in a historic hammam, such as Agha Mikayil, Akhund, or Taza Bey
- Relive your childhood magic at the Baku State Circus
- Witness the natural phenomenon of Yanar Dag, the famous burning mountain
- Discover Baku's vibrant nightlife with its trendy bars and buzzing energy
- Explore the ancient petroglyphs and famous mud volcanoes at the Gobustan National Park

- **Kebabs**, including premium sturgeon shashlik

- **Hand-woven Carpet** – a timeless piece of Azerbaijani art

- **Saj** – a traditional flat griddle pan
